## AN ACT

Relating to participation by employees of the North Pacific Fishery Management Council in the public employees' retirement and insurance system; and providing for an effective date.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 39.35 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 39.35.154. NORTH PACIFIC FISHERY MANAGEMENT COUNCIL EMPLOYEES. Employees of the North Pacific Fishery Management Council appointed under 16 U.S.C. 1852(f)(1) (sec. 302(f)(1) of P. L. 94-265), whose compensation is paid from allotted federal funds, are included in the system if the council pays the employer's contributions. If the employer's contributions are not paid when due, no credited service for the period of delinquency may be granted until the contributions are paid.

\* Sec. 2. AS 39.30.100(2) is amended to read:

(2) "governmental unit" means the state, a borough, municipal corporation, or other political subdivision of the state, and the North Pacific Fishery Management Council;

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1977.
