AN ACT

Relating to child care; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 47.35.010(b) is amended to read:

(b) The department shall, within 90 days after receiving a written request that it do so, delegate its powers relating to nurseries under this section and under secs. 40, 50 and 60 of this chapter to a municipality which has adopted an ordinance providing for day care licensing under home rule powers or as authorized under AS 29.48.035(a)(20). A municipality to which these powers have been delegated may waive or modify any regulation or standard established by the department under the authority of secs. 10 - 80 of this chapter as it applies to nurseries or the application of any such regulation or standard as it applies to a particular day care licensee but must notify the department of any waiver.

* Sec. 2. AS 44.47.310(3) is repealed and re-enacted to read:

(3) "child" means any person below 11 years of age.

* Sec. 3. AS 44.47.280(4) is repealed.

* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1977.
