Relating to the Alaska American Revolution Bicentennial Commission.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Legislature created the Alaska American Revolution Bicentennial Commission by ch. 32, SLA 1972; and

WHEREAS the Governor appointed members, and the Commission began its work in March, 1973; and

WHEREAS the Commission furnished imaginative and foresighted leadership for communities and individuals in the celebration of the United States' Bicentennial; and

WHEREAS commemoration of the Bicentennial in Alaska was carried out in a dignified and patriotic manner, and each community had the opportunity to choose projects in harmony with its traditions, environment, and size; and

WHEREAS the Commission completed its work and was dissolved on December 31, 1976;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature commends the Alaska American Revolution Bicentennial Commission for its outstanding accomplishments.
