Congratulating Donald L. McQueen on the occasion of his retirement from state service.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Donald L. McQueen is retiring from his position as Deputy Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS Deputy Commissioner McQueen's dedicated and selfless service to the people of the State of Alaska spans a period of more than 20 years in law enforcement positions throughout the state, including assignment as a trooper in Fairbanks, Haines and Juneau; command of the State Troopers' Northwest Alaska Region and of "C" Detachment in Anchorage; Acting Director of the Alaska State Troopers; and two appointments to the position of Deputy Commissioner of the Department of Public Safety; and

WHEREAS, in addition to prior military service and the above-cited law enforcement service, Deputy Commissioner McQueen has actively furthered the cause of justice through membership and offices in numerous law enforcement organizations, including the Alaska Peace Officers Association, the Pacific Northwest National Academy Association, and the International Association of Chiefs of Police; and

WHEREAS Deputy Commissioner Don McQueen is retiring from the Department of Public Safety on the 15th day of February, 1977, and departs with the honored respect of his colleagues for his devotion to protecting Alaska's citizens and their property from crime;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that Deputy Commissioner Donald L. McQueen is commended for his outstanding duty to law and order in behalf of the people of the State of Alaska and honored on the occasion of his retirement.
