Relating to the Alaska State Office in Tokyo.

### BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the Alaska State Office is maintained in Tokyo as an outlet for economic development, resource, and trade information, and as a contact point for government and private industry of Alaska and the Far East in promoting and carrying on trade between the state and the Far East; and

WHEREAS the office is an agency of the State of Alaska staffed by personnel selected by the Governor on the basis of experience, training and familiarity with Alaska and the Far East; and

WHEREAS it is essential to the successful conduct of the office that it be centrally located and easily accessible to visitors;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to move the Alaska State Office in Tokyo to a central area somewhere near the American Embassy; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Governor is respectfully requested to investigate the advantages to the state of expanding the Alaska State Office for the purpose of promoting tourism and the development of Alaska, including the bottomfish industry.
