Relating to the ninth annual Girls' State at Sitka.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the ninth annual Girls' State will be held June 5 - 12, 1977, at the State Trooper Academy at Sitka under the sponsorship of the American Legion Auxiliary and cooperating civic organizations; and

WHEREAS this Alaska effort is part of a national program designed to provide delegates with an opportunity to develop an awareness of many of the facets of state and local government; and

WHEREAS this week-long exercise in participatory citizenship is made possible by the application of the best elements of volunteer service and free enterprise completely free from government interference and any burden on the taxpayer; and

WHEREAS since the legislative portion of the program would be enhanced by the participation of state and local legislators and the availability of materials describing the Alaska legislative process;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature commends the sponsors of Girls' State for their fine program; encourages business and labor organizations and private citizens to participate in this meritorious endeavor; requests the Legislative Affairs Agency to continue to provide the program with the appropriate legislative publications and have an attorney explain the important bill drafting process to the delegates; and requests the presiding officers of each house of the Legislature to encourage members to attend the ninth annual Girls' State to assist in the legislative portion of the program.
