Honoring the memory of Mark Jacobs, Sr.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Death has taken Mark Jacobs, Sr. of Sitka.

Mark Jacobs led an active life as a commercial fisherman of recognized ability and as an energetic participant in community affairs.

He was a charter member of the Sitka Camp of the Alaska Native Brotherhood when it was organized over 60 years ago. He was a Past President of the Brotherhood's Grand Camp, served on its Executive Committee, and was active in Tlingit-Haida activities in Sitka.

Mark Jacobs had a long association with Alaska government having served on the Board of the Sick and Disabled Fishermen's Fund and during the period 1942 - 1970 served as doorman for the Territorial and State House of Representatives and Senate. He was an energetic member of the Sitka precinct of the Republican Party for over 20 years and was widely respected for his encouragement of young people to attain higher levels of education.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the passing of Mark Jacobs, Sr. of Sitka is noted with sorrow and the sincerest condolences are extended to his widow, Annie Jacobs, and the other members of the family on their loss which is shared by all Alaskans.
