Honoring Roy Rickey for his service to Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Roy Rickey will be retiring from public service and his current position as Chairman of the Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission later this year.

Mr. Rickey received his degree in fisheries from the University of Washington in 1949 and since that time has been involved in research and administration related to the Alaska fishery.

He entered Alaska service in 1954 at Kodiak with the Territorial Department of Fisheries and in 1960 was appointed the Westward Supervisor for the State Department of Fish and Game. In 1961 he was appointed Southeast Alaska Supervisor headquartered at Juneau and in 1971 became the Director of Commercial Fisheries of the Department of Fish and Game.

In 1973 Roy Rickey was appointed to the Commercial Fisheries Entry Commission and became Chairman of the Commission in 1974.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Legislature extends to Roy Rickey its congratulations for over two decades of service to the Territory and State of Alaska and adds its best wishes for a happy and productive retirement.
