* Section 1. AS 08.62.190 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.62.190. PENALTY. A master or owner of a vessel required by this chapter to employ a licensed pilot who fails to do so when a licensed pilot is available, unless the perils or hazards of the sea prevent the employment of a pilot, is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine of not less than \$1,000 [\$500] nor more than \$5,000 [\$1,000]. A person who violates any other provision of this chapter or a regulation adopted under it is guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction, is punishable by a fine of not less than \$500 nor more than \$1,000.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-070(c).
