AN ACT

Relating to foreign trade zones; and providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. AS 45 is amended by adding a new chapter to read:

CHAPTER 77. FOREIGN TRADE ZONES.

Sec. 45.77.010. APPLICATION FOR ESTABLISHMENT OF FOREIGN TRADE ZONE. As applicable the following may apply to the United States Department of Commerce to establish, operate, and maintain foreign trade zones as provided in the Foreign Trade Zones Act (19 U.S.C. 81a - 19 U.S.C. 81u):

(1) the commissioner of commerce and economic development, if the foreign trade zone is to be established, operated, and maintained by the state, or a corporation qualified under (3) of this section;

(2) the local governing body of a municipality by ordinance or resolution, if the foreign trade zone is to be established, operated, and maintained by the municipality within its corporate boundaries;

(3) those officers of a corporation who may be authorized by law or by the bylaws of the corporation, if they apply through the commissioner of commerce and economic development and in a manner consistent with the articles of incorporation of the corporation.

* Sec. 2. AS 29.53.020(a) is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

(7) inventories located within a foreign trade zone established under AS 45.77.010, before those inventories are cleared by the United States Customs Service and admitted into domestic commerce.
