Relating to the Richardson Highway.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:**

WHEREAS the Richardson Highway is a main artery of commerce from Alaska's interior to the sea; and

WHEREAS businessmen making shipments through the port of Valdez are obliged to use the Richardson Highway; and

WHEREAS grain grown for export in the future will be trucked down the Richardson Highway; and

WHEREAS the Richardson Highway is the connection to the terminus of the Alaska Marine Highway System at Valdez; and

WHEREAS the Richardson Highway is the only land connection with Interior Alaska for the growing community of Valdez; and

WHEREAS much of the Richardson Highway needs upgrading;

BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives respectfully requests the Governor to direct the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to upgrade the Richardson Highway.
