Relating to the allocation of state money for the survey of state land in the Delta II agricultural development project and for set net fishing sites in tidal and riparian areas.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the legislature has appropriated \$6,903,100 to the Department of Natural Resources for cadastral land surveying during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1982; and

WHEREAS the legislature has enacted House CS for CS for Senate Bill No. 59 establishing the Delta II agricultural development project and authorizing the Department of Natural Resources to prepare state land for sale for agricultural use; and

WHEREAS many set net fishing sites traditionally utilized in tidal and riparian areas have yet to be identified by survey monumentation for exact location; and

WHEREAS it is in the best interest of the state to adequately record and identify all set net fishing sites utilized in tidal and riparian areas;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that the governor is respectfully requested to direct the commissioner of natural resources to allocate \$543,000 of the amount appropriated to the Department of Natural Resources for cadastral land surveying to survey state land for agricultural use within the Delta II agricultural project; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that the governor is respectfully requested to direct the commissioner of natural resources to allocate \$400,000 of the amount appropriated to the Department of Natural Resources for the necessary surveying of state land in tidal and riparian areas utilized for set net fishing sites, and to provide procedures for lessees to reimburse the state for survey costs.
