Relating to planning for the new capital city.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the New Capital Site Planning Commission is authorized by the legislature under AS 44.06 to plan for the development of the capital site for a new capital city; and

WHEREAS the commission has prepared and submitted to the legislature a plan as required by AS 44.06.230(j); and

WHEREAS AS 44.06.230(i) provides:

"(i) The commission may undertake other activities as are appropriate to carry out its functions, including but not limited to investigating the most economical and expeditious means of procurement, construction methods, construction alternatives, and labor costs.";

and

WHEREAS development of an alternative plan for a capital city adequate for its purposes but lower in cost than the plan prepared under AS 44.06.230(j) is an activity that is very appropriate in carrying out the function of the commission to investigate the most economical and expeditious means of development of a new capital; and

WHEREAS it is possible that funds for development of a lower-cost alternative plan could be obtained from private grants or grants from public agencies;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska House of Representatives:

(1) that the governor is respectfully requested to make appointments of members to the New Capital Site Planning Commission to fill existing or future vacancies on the commission; and

(2) that the New Capital Site Planning Commission is requested to explore possibilities of obtaining private grants or public grants for preparation of an alternative plan for development of the capital city at a lower cost and, if funds become available, to prepare an alternative lower-cost plan for submission to the legislature.
