## AN ACT

Making special appropriations to the Department of Commerce and Economic Development for the Alaska Agricultural Action Council for a small grain marketing system.

---

\* Section 1. The sum of \$8,200,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Commerce and Economic Development for the Alaska Agricultural Action Council for the following facilities for a small grain marketing system:

construction of a tidewater grain terminal	\$6,500,000
construction of a grain sub-terminal and elevator facility between Fairbanks and Delta Junction	700,000
railroad hopper cars	1,000,000

\* Sec. 2. The sum of \$300,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Department of Commerce and Economic Development for the Alaska Agricultural Action Council to contract for organization and operation of a marketing system to purchase and resell small grains grown in Alaska.

\* Sec. 3. The appropriation made by sec. 1 of this Act is for capital projects and is subject to AS 37.25.020.

\* Sec. 4. The unexpended and unobligated portion of the appropriation made by sec. 2 of this Act lapses into the general fund June 30, 1982.
