AN ACT

Naming the Douglas bridge; and providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. AS 19.10 is amended by adding a new section to read:

ARTICLE 4. NAMES OF HIGHWAYS AND BRIDGES.

Sec. 19.10.300. DOUGLAS BRIDGE. The bridge across the Gastineau Channel connecting Juneau with Douglas Island is named the Douglas Bridge.

* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-070(c).
