~~* Sec. 2. The sum of \$25,600,000 is appropriated from the general fund to the Alaska Power Authority for continuing studies, licensing, pre-construction design and engineering for the Susitna hydroelectric project.~~

* Sec. 3. The appropriations in sec. 4 of this Act are from the general fund.
