\* Section 1. AS 41.15.210 is amended to read:

Sec. 41.15.210. FIRE SUPPRESSION FUND. A fire suppression fund is established in the state treasury for the use of the Department of Natural Resources. The fund shall be used for actual expenses incurred in the suppression of fires. The fund may not be used for capital expenditures.

\* Sec. 2. Section 2, ch. 171, SLA 1980 is amended to read:

Sec. 2. Notwithstanding the provisions of AS 37.07.080(e) or the provisions of AS 37.05.159(b), the governor may transfer up to \$9,000,000 [\$5,000,000] during a fiscal year from the reserve for emergency operating expenses account to the fire suppression fund to pay the costs of fire suppression.

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-070(c).
