* Section 1. AS 18.60.580 is amended to read:

Sec. 18.60.580. MINIMUM ELECTRICAL STANDARDS. The 1981 [1978] published edition of the National Electrical Code approved by the American Standards Association, and the latest published edition of the National Electrical Safety Code issued by the United States Department of Commerce, Bureau of Standards, constitute the minimum electrical safety standards of the state.

* Sec. 2. AS 18.60.590(a) is amended to read:

(a) The department may by regulation adopt amendments to the 1981 [1975] National Electrical Code as approved and issued by the American Standards Association.

* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.10.-070(c).
