AN ACT

Relating to regulation and licensing of veterinarians.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Relating to regulation and licensing of veterinarians.

* Section 1. AS 08.98.050(9) is amended to read:

(9) collect, or cause to be collected, data concerning the practice of veterinary technology [MEDICINE] by veterinary technicians in the state and submit the data to the department for maintenance;

* Sec. 2. AS 08.98.180 is amended to read:

Sec. 08.98.180. TEMPORARY LICENSE. A person who meets the requirements of AS 08.98.165(a)(1) and (5) is entitled to be temporarily licensed after applying for examination, if the person works under the supervision of a licensed veterinarian [COMPLETING THE EXAMINATIONS UNDER AS 08.98.165(a)(3) AND (4) AND AFTER COMPLETING THE EXAMINATION REQUIRED UNDER AS 08.98.165(a)(2) OR QUALIFYING FOR AN EXEMPTION TO IT]. A license issued under this section is valid until the results of the examinations are published. No person may receive more than one temporary license. An application for a temporary license must be signed by the supervising veterinarian and accompanied by the temporary license fee as prescribed under AS 08.98.190.
