Relating to the establishment of a Senate Special Committee on Property Taxation.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS there is substantial public interest in property tax relief; and

WHEREAS several property tax measures have been introduced during the First Session of the Twelfth Legislature; and

WHEREAS property taxation is a complex subject requiring comprehensive study and planning; and

WHEREAS changes in property tax laws would affect several competing interests that need to be adequately addressed and represented;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Senate that a Senate Special Committee on Property Taxation is established to study, take testimony, and make proposals concerning various aspects of property taxation in the state, as the committee considers appropriate; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee consists of five senators; the president of the senate shall appoint the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee is authorized to meet during and between sessions of the legislature and shall terminate January 10, 1983.
