Relating to Cook Inlet fish resources.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the state has a duty to manage wisely the state's fish resources through scientific methods; and

WHEREAS commercial, personal use, and subsistence fishermen have important interests in the management and yield of Cook Inlet fish resources; and

WHEREAS the state has a duty to fairly apportion the Cook Inlet fish resources among all groups of fishermen; and

WHEREAS the Board of Fisheries has proposed a subsistence plan which would deprive some groups of fishermen of a fair portion of Cook Inlet fish resources;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska Senate urges the Board of Fisheries to define subsistence fisheries use in a manner that will minimize the impact on hook and line personal use and commercial fisheries in Cook Inlet; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board of Fisheries allocate the fish resources in a manner similar to the intent of the 1977 upper Cook Inlet fish resources management plan.
