AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Department of Environmental Conservation for water and sewer grants, and special appropriations for payment as grants to municipalities and unincorporated communities for water, sewer, and solid waste grants; and providing for an effective date.

AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Department of Environmental Conservation for water and sewer grants, and special appropriations for payment as grants to municipalities and unincorporated communities for water, sewer, and solid waste grants; and providing for an effective date.
