\* Section 1. AS 28.40.100(a)(9) is amended to read:

(9) "motor-driven cycle" means a motorcycle, motor scooter, motorized bicycle, or similar conveyance with a motor attached and having an engine with 50 or less [THAN 150] cubic centimeters of displacement [OR WITH NOT TO EXCEED FIVE BRAKE-HORSEPOWER];
