\* Section 1. AS 14.25.220(8) is amended to read:

(8) "BIA service" means service, including partial years,  
as a teacher, a certificated person employed in a full-time position  
requiring a teaching certificate as a condition of employment, or a  
Bureau of Indian Affairs professional educator in a school or school  
system operated by the Bureau of Indian Affairs in Alaska;

\* Sec. 2. A member qualified under amendments made by sec. 1 of this  
Act may claim prior service if the member pays the arrearage indebtedness  
in accordance with AS 14.25.060.
