\* Section 1. AS 29.13.010(b) is amended to read:

(b) A charter is framed by a charter commission of seven members chosen by the municipal voters at a regular or special election. A candidate for the charter commission shall have been [BE A] qualified to vote in [VOTER OF] the municipality [AND A RESIDENT OF THE MUNICIPALITY] for at least one year [THREE YEARS] immediately preceding the charter commission election.

\* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect immediately in accordance with AS 01.-10.070(c).
