Establishing a House Special Committee on Fisheries.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:**

WHEREAS the fishing industry has contributed heavily to the state's economy and will continue to be important to it; and

WHEREAS the instability of the commercial fishing industry in the state often presents critical problems for the financing of ventures of those who fish, fish processors, and many fisheries-related businesses; and

WHEREAS it is critical that the Fourteenth Alaska State Legislature be well informed on all aspects of the fishing industry;

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives that the House Special Committee on Fisheries is established to study the problems of the fisheries and the commercial fishing industry in the state; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the speaker of the house shall determine the number of representatives to be members of the committee, and shall appoint the members and designate a member to chair the committee; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the House Special Committee on Fisheries may meet during and between sessions of the legislature, and is terminated on the convening of the First Session of the Fifteenth Legislature.
