Relating to designating Hyder, Alaska, as "Mile 0" of the Alaska-Yukon Highway.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES:

WHEREAS the Hyder-Stewart-Cassiar Highway road dedication occurred this past summer; and

WHEREAS the Hyder-Stewart-Cassiar Highway is Alaska's newest paved highway open year round; and

WHEREAS the Hyder-Stewart-Cassiar Highway creates a direct link to the lower 48 states and Canada; and

WHEREAS the Hyder-Stewart-Cassiar Highway opens the Southeast Alaska corridor to the Ketchikan Tongass National Forest and the Misty Fjord National Forest; and

WHEREAS the community of Hyder, Alaska, rich in mining history and scenic splendor, marks the beginning of the Hyder-Stewart-Cassiar-Alaska-Yukon Highway;

BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives respectfully requests the Governor to direct the Department of Transportation and Public Facilities to designate Hyder, Alaska, as "Mile 0" of the Alaska-Yukon Highway.
