Authorizing a recess by the Senate or the House of Representatives for a period of more than three days.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS art. II, sec. 10, Constitution of the State of Alaska, provides that neither house may adjourn or recess for longer than three days unless the other house concurs; and

WHEREAS Rule 52, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, provides that adoption of a concurrent resolution by a majority vote of the full membership of each house constitutes concurrence; and

WHEREAS the legislature has been called into special session to consider the question of impeachment of the Governor; and

WHEREAS art. II, sec. 19, Constitution of the State of Alaska, provides that impeachment shall originate in the Senate and that trial on impeachment shall be conducted by the House of Representatives; and

WHEREAS there may be periods during the proceedings when the presence of the full Senate or full House is not required and therefore requiring daily sessions of the Senate or House, or either, is not necessary;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Senate or the House of Representatives may recess for periods in excess of three days to the call of the chair if authorized by vote of the body and that the Senate and the House of Representatives concur in that recess.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Senate respectfully requests the Judicial Council to study use of the power of the grand jury to investigate and make recommendations and that the council make recommendations to the supreme court and the legislature to assure effective and proper use of that power with effective safeguards to prevent abuse and assure basic fairness; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Senate respectfully requests the Judicial Council to consider a possible amendment to the State Constitution for presentation to the voters for ratification concerning the need to strengthen the grand jury system consistent with due process and standards established through publications including but not limited to materials published by the National Institute of Justice, United States Department of Justice, Grand Jury Reform: A Review of Key Issues, 1983.

Establishing a Select Interim Committee on Procurement Practices and Procedures.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS the impeachment inquiry into the conduct of the Governor of the State of Alaska has arisen as a consequence of a Grand Jury report; and

WHEREAS the scope of the inquiry of the Senate has been congruent with the scope of the Grand Jury report; and

WHEREAS other questions have arisen during the course of the inquiry that are beyond the scope of the Grand Jury report; and

WHEREAS the Senate desires to fulfill its responsibilities, without unduly prolonging the Special Session, dissipating or wasting resources of time or money, or violating the rights of any person to Due Process of Law;

BE IT RESOLVED that

(1) there be established by the Senate a Select Interim Committee on Procurement Practices and Procedures, charged with the responsibility of reviewing and investigating the subject matter set out below in paragraph five, and reporting its findings and conclusions to the Senate and the public no later than the 13th day of January, 1986;

(2) the Committee shall consist of an equal number of Republicans and Democrats appointed by the President of the Senate;

(3) the Committee is authorized and empowered to employ legal counsel and to employ or contract for investigative services;

(4) to the greatest possible extent, the Committee shall utilize existing legislative staff and office space;

(5) the Committee shall review, investigate, and

render advice with respect to

(A) Grand Jury recommendations concerning the Alaska statutes governing sole-source contracts, bid waivers, a code of ethics for the executive branch, employee awareness of ethical obligations, procedures to protect the state's competitive bidding process, and problems presented by approaches made to governmental officials to promote private pecuniary interests;

(B) other changes in procurement procedures that may be suggested by the testimony taken during the impeachment inquiry or during proceedings of the Select Interim Committee itself;

(6) prior to any public release of the Committee's findings and conclusions, the Committee shall submit to the Governor a draft of its report, including its tentative findings and conclusions, and the Governor shall be afforded the opportunity to submit to the Committee a written response and commentary to it, or requests for revisions, and the final findings and conclusions, at the time of public release, shall have attached to them the written comment or response of the Governor, if any;

(7) the expenses of the Committee may be paid from any funds available to the leadership of the Senate.
