Thirty-third Day

Pursuant to adjournment, the Senate was called to order by President Bennett at 11:08 a.m.

The roll showed twelve members present. Senators Fahrenkamp, Vic Fischer, Josephson, Sackett, Sturgulewski and Zharoff were excused from a call of the Senate. Senators Faiks and Ferguson were absent.

The prayer was offered by the Chaplain, Reverend Art Knight of the United Methodist Church of Douglas.
