Pursuant to AS 24.60.070, I would like to disclose to the committee the formation of a close economic association involving a substantial financial matter with a registered lobbyist and with a public official in another branch.

I am the president of, and a minority shareholder in the Alaska Pacific Catering Corporation. This corporation owns a 5% share of Thin Ice Productions, a limited partnership. A 5% share of Thin Ice is also owned by Ed Dankworth, a registered lobbyist.

Thin Ice owns 50% of the stock in Smith/Biss Ventures, Inc., a corporation which operates the Old Anchorage Salmon Bake. Don Smith, a former elected official of the Municipality of Anchorage, is the owner of the remaining stock.
