AN ACT

Relating to pharmaceutical medical assistance for needy persons and authorizing payment for prescribed drugs for a period of one year; and providing for an effective date.

\* Section 1. PRESCRIBED DRUGS UNDER MEDICAID. (a) Notwithstanding other provisions of law, the Department of Health and Social Services may offer prescribed drugs as an optional service under AS 47.07.030(b).

(b) For purposes of AS 47.07.035, prescribed drugs shall be eliminated as an optional medical service after personal care services in a recipient's home and before long-term care noninstitutional services.

(c) Payment for prescribed drugs under AS 47.07 shall be made in accordance with 42 C.F.R. Part 447, Subpart D.

(d) In this section, "prescribed drugs" has the meaning given in 42 C.F.R. 440.120.

\* Sec. 2. This Act is repealed July 1, 1989.

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1988.
