AN ACT

Relating to the registration of general contractors and subcontractors and to certain contracts of state agencies.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Relating to the registration of general contractors and subcontractors and to certain contracts of state agencies.

* Section 1. AS 08.18.011(b) is amended to read:

(b) A general contractor may not use a bid or proposal from, award a bid or proposal to, contract with, or allow a person required to be registered under this chapter to work for the general contractor as a specialty contractor unless the person is registered under this chapter.

* Sec. 2. AS 36.30.115(a) is amended to read:

(a) Within five working days after the identification of the apparent low bidder, the apparent low bidder shall submit a list of the subcontractors the bidder proposes to use in the performance of the contract. The list must include the name and location of the place of business for each subcontractor and evidence of the subcontractor's valid Alaska business license. A bidder for a construction contract shall also submit evidence of each subcontractor's registration under AS 08.18. If a subcontractor on the list did not have a valid Alaska business license and a valid certificate of registration under AS 08.18 at the time the bid was opened, the bidder may not use the subcontractor in the performance of the contract, and shall replace the subcontractor with a subcontractor who had a valid Alaska business license and a valid certificate of registration under AS 08.18 at the
