AN ACT

Relating to the disposal of property forfeited under
federal drug enforcement laws.

* Section 1. AS 17.30.100 is amended by adding a new subsection to
read:

(d) The Department of Public Safety or a local law enforcement
agency may accept from the United States Attorney General property,
including money, that is forfeited under 21 U.S.C. 881 (the Controlled
Substances Act). The Department of Public Safety and local law
enforcement agencies shall, in accordance with 21 U.S.C. 881(e) and
regulations and policies adopted under that section, use property and
the proceeds of property obtained under this subsection in the
enforcement of this chapter, AS 11.71, and municipal ordinances sub-
stantially similar to this chapter and AS 11.71.

* Sec. 2. This Act is retroactive to January 1, 1985.
