\* Section 1. AS 12.55.085(a) is amended to read:

(a) Except as provided in (f) of this section, if [IF] it appears that there are circumstances in mitigation of the punishment, or that the ends of justice will be served, the court may, in its discretion, suspend the imposition of sentence and may direct that the suspension continue for a period of time, not exceeding the maximum term of sentence that [WHICH] may be imposed, and upon the terms and conditions that [WHICH] the court determines, and shall place the person on probation, under the charge and supervision of the probation officer of the court during the suspension.

\* Sec. 2. AS 12.55.085 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(f) The court may not suspend the imposition of sentence of a person who is convicted of a violation of AS 11.41.410 - 11.41.455.
