BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

AN ACT

Relating to salaries of certain state employees who are not members of a collective bargaining unit; and providing for an effective date.

* Section 1. SALARIES OF CLASSIFIED AND PARTIALLY EXEMPT EXECUTIVE-BRANCH EMPLOYEES NOT IN A COLLECTIVE BARGAINING UNIT. Notwithstanding AS 39.27.011(a), the basic monthly salaries of classified and partially exempt employees who are not members of a collective bargaining unit established under AS 23.40 shall be adjusted by the same percentage of adjustments in the basic monthly salaries paid to members of the general government collective bargaining unit, for any period beginning after June 30, 1987. The adjustments for the classified and partially exempt employees not in a collective bargaining unit shall be made in the same pay period that a new pay plan is implemented for the general government unit by the state. The classified and partially exempt employees who are not in a collective bargaining unit shall be paid according to AS 39.27.011(a) until the first pay period of implementation of a new pay plan for the general government unit.

* Sec. 2. SALARIES OF EXEMPT EMPLOYEES OF THE EXECUTIVE BRANCH. Salary adjustments comparable to those received by the classified and partially exempt employees of the executive branch under sec. 1 of this Act shall be made for permanent and temporary employees of the executive branch who are in the exempt service under AS 39.25.110, and who are not members of a collective bargaining unit established under the Public Employment
