AN ACT

* Section 1. AS 39.25.150(19)(A) is amended to read:

(A) "veteran" means a person with 181 days or more active service in the armed forces of the United States who has been honorably discharged after having served during any period between April 6, 1917, and December 1, 1919, between September 16, 1940, and December 31, 1947, or between June 27, 1950, and October 14, 1976 [NOVEMBER 7, 1975];
