AN ACT

Relating to the Department of Public Safety's authority to award grants that relate to the duties and powers of the highway safety planning agency and the division of fire prevention; and providing for an effective date.

\* Section 1. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. The intent of this Act is to provide the Department of Public Safety with the authority to implement legislative grant appropriations related to the highway safety planning agency and the division of fire prevention when the department has no other statutory authority to implement the grant.

\* Sec. 2. AS 44.41 is amended by adding a new section to read:

Sec. 44.41.021. GRANT AUTHORITY. The Department of Public Safety may award grants necessary or incidental to the performance of the duties and execution of the powers of the highway safety planning agency and the division of fire prevention.

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect July 1, 1988.
