Relating to encouraging private industry to hire state residents and to contract with local businesses.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the hiring of state residents is an important public policy issue to the citizens of the state; and

WHEREAS public support for hiring state residents increases as the number of jobs in the state economy decreases; and

WHEREAS the state has a pool of skilled workers and organizations from which private industry could, in most instances, find the persons necessary to fulfill its contracts and fill its employment positions; and

WHEREAS businesses, especially those controlled by nonresident or foreign interests, must be made aware of the importance of giving state residents a chance to work in the state;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the commissioner of labor to embark on a public awareness and promotional campaign to encourage private industry to hire state residents and to contract with state businesses for projects located in the state.
