Relating to the visit to Alaska by Governor Hou Jie of the Province of Heilongjiang, and the special relationship between that province and the State of Alaska.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS, the people of the Province of Heilongjiang, in the People's Republic of China, and the people of the State of Alaska on February 5, 1985, established a relationship of special friendship; and

WHEREAS, through this special relationship both peoples seek to have richer, more productive lives through economic cooperation, trade, educational exchanges, cultural exchanges, and people-to-people contact; and

WHEREAS, the Honorable Hou Jie, Governor of the Province of Heilongjiang, led a six-member delegation of distinguished provincial leaders to promote and advance this cooperation and exchange; and

WHEREAS, through the efforts of Governor Hou, his delegation, and the Alaskan people, substantial and concrete progress was made in the areas of fisheries, urea, timber, oil technology, power generation, and the exchanges of students, scholars, researchers, cultural artifacts, artistic performances, and zoo animals;

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Governor and the Legislature of the State of Alaska extend their best wishes and warmest regards to Governor Hou and the people of Heilongjiang, as well as their hopes for continued good relations between Alaska and the People's Republic of China.
