Recognizing the importance of secretaries, certified professional secretaries, and professional legal secretaries; and requesting the Governor to designate April 25 - 29, 1988, as State Secretaries' Week and April 27, 1988, as State Secretaries' Day.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS secretaries perform a myriad of tasks that require a broad range of skills and knowledge related to behavioral sciences, business and business law, the English language, office management, economics, communications, sales and marketing, and office technology; and

WHEREAS certified professional secretaries and professional legal secretaries have demonstrated especially outstanding skills by successfully completing rigorous examinations; and

WHEREAS most offices and heads of offices could not perform their functions without the dedicated services of their secretarial staff; and

WHEREAS April 25 - 29, 1988, is Professional Secretaries' Week and April 27, 1988, is Professional Secretaries' Day;

BE IT RESOLVED that the Alaska State Legislature commends the efficiency and resourcefulness of the secretaries who are employed in the state; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislature respectfully requests the Governor to designate April 25 - 29, 1988, as State Secretaries' Week, and April 27, 1988, as State Secretaries' Day; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the legislature respectfully requests the Governor to direct the division of personnel to formally recognize certified professional secretaries and professional legal secretaries as "exceptionally qualified" and to explore methods of adequately compensating employees who attain either of

these designations.
