Relating to naming a harbor for Don D. Statter.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS Don D. Statter was appointed the director of the division of water and harbors in the Department of Public Works in 1966, a position he retained until his retirement in 1982; and

WHEREAS during his tenure as director he established a statewide boat harbor and port system; and

WHEREAS one of his major objectives as director was to build the best possible harbor facilities for the least cost to the state; and

WHEREAS Don Statter was instrumental in laying the ground work to make the Auke Bay Harbor Project possible; and

WHEREAS, after his retirement, Don continued to pursue his interest in the development and operation of local harbors, ensuring adequate facilities for the boating public by serving the public as a member of the Juneau Harbor Board of Directors;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that the Governor is respectfully requested to direct the commissioner of transportation and public facilities to name the state-owned facilities at Auke Bay Harbor, including the transient moorage, boat harbor, and floating breakwater, the Don D. Statter Harbor.
