Establishing a Senate Special Committee on International Trade.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS international trade is of increasing importance to the economy of the state; and

WHEREAS the legislature should be well-informed about developments in international trade in order to plan for the state's future; and

WHEREAS the state should promote and facilitate the export of the products and services of the state;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate that a Senate Special Committee on International Trade is established to study issues relating to international trade; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the president of the senate shall appoint members of the Senate to serve on the committee; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the Senate Special Committee on International Trade may meet during and between sessions of the legislature, and is terminated on the convening of the First Session of the Sixteenth Legislature.
