Dedicating the Second Session of the Fifteenth Alaska State Legislature to the late Senator Don Bennett.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:

WHEREAS Senator Don Bennett represented the people of Fairbanks in the Alaska House of Representatives for two years and the Alaska Senate for 10 years, having served as cochairman of the Finance Committee during the Thirteenth Legislature, as President of the Senate during the Fourteenth Legislature, and as cochairman of the Finance Committee during the Fifteenth Legislature, a position he held at the time of this death, August 30, 1987; and

WHEREAS Senator Bennett represented his constituents vigorously, even when the cause became controversial; and

WHEREAS Senator Bennett brought to this service in the legislature an ability to remain calm and respond with courtesy to others even in the midst of political maelstroms; and

WHEREAS Senator Bennett's experience and concern for the welfare of the people of Alaska will be sorely missed by the Senate during the Second Session of the Fifteenth Legislature;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate that the Second Session of the Fifteenth Alaska State Legislature is dedicated to the late Senator Don Bennett to honor his contributions to the Senate and to acknowledge that this legacy forms a vital part of the foundation of this body.
