Establishing a Senate Special Committee on Local and Regional Economic Opportunity.

**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE:**

WHEREAS the Alaska state government has been heavily dependent on a source of revenue that is subject to world-wide fluctuation beyond the control of the state; and

WHEREAS the economy of the state is tied closely to state spending of revenue derived from this one source; and

WHEREAS this dependency has resulted in an unstable economic condition for the residents of the state; and

WHEREAS the promotion, development, and marketing of other state resources and the enhancement of other Alaska business activity on local and regional levels may offer an alternative to the state's dependence on a single industry;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Senate that a Senate Special Committee on Local and Regional Economic Opportunity is established to examine the potential for economic diversification in the state; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that the president of the Senate shall determine the number of senators to be appointed to the special committee and appoint the chair and members of the special committee; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED the special committee may meet during and between sessions of the Fifteenth State Legislature and is terminated on the convening of the Sixteenth State Legislature.
