AN ACT

Relating to elevator safety standards; and providing for an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 18.60.800(a) is amended to read:

(a) Except as provided in this subsection, the 1987 [1984] edition of the American National Standards Institute Safety Code for Elevators and Escalators (ANSI/ASME A17.1) published by the American Society of Mechanical Engineers is adopted as the minimum elevator safety code in the state. Section [111.12, RESTRICTED OPENING OF HOISTWAY DOORS AND/OR CAR DOORS ON PASSENGER ELEVATORS, AND SECTION] 1001.1, Inspection and Test Periods of the American National Standards Institute Safety Code for Elevators and Escalators, is [ARE] not adopted as a part of the minimum elevator safety code in the state.

* Sec. 2. AS 18.60.800(c) is amended to read:

(c) Inspections of elevators by the department shall [MUST] be performed in accordance with the procedures set out in the [NATIONAL SAFETY PRACTICE FOR THE INSPECTION OF ELEVATORS AND ESCALATORS (Inspector's Manual for Elevators and Escalators - ANSI/ASME A17.2 []) as approved in 1988 [1982].

* Sec. 3. Under AS 18.60.800(a), as amended by sec. 1 of this Act, Section 111.12, Restricted Opening of Hoistway Doors or Car Doors on Passenger Elevators, which is found in the 1987 edition of the American National Standards Institute Safety Code ~~for~~ Elevators and Escalators (ANSI/ASME A17.1) published by the American Society of Mechanical
