AN ACT

Relating to eligibility for veterans' death gratuities.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

AN ACT

Relating to eligibility for veterans' death gratuities.

* Section 1. AS 26.10.080(a) is amended to read:

(a) The Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs shall pay, upon application, a death gratuity in the amount of \$750 to the surviving spouse of a qualified veteran [WHOSE BURIAL IN THE STATE OCCURS ON OR AFTER MAY 13, 1984, AND] who was a resident of the state at the time of death. If the veteran has no surviving spouse, the gratuity shall be paid to the personal representative of the veteran. A veteran is qualified under this subsection if the veteran's

(1) burial occurred in the state on or after May 13, 1984;

or

(2) death occurred on or after the effective date of this

Act.
