AN ACT

Relating to the examination of regulations and of opinions and decisions issued by courts and agencies on the law of the state.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 24.20.065(a) is amended to read:

(a) The legislative council shall annually examine administrative regulations, published opinions of state and federal courts and of the Department of Law [THAT RELY ON STATE STATUTES], and final decisions adopted under the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62) that rely on state statutes or the common law of the state to determine if [WHETHER OR NOT]

(1) the courts and agencies are properly implementing legislative purposes;

(2) there are court or agency expressions of dissatisfaction with state statutes or the common law of the state;

(3) the opinions, decisions, or regulations indicate unclear or ambiguous statutes;

(4) the courts have modified or revised the common law of the state.
