AN ACT

Relating to the notice requirements for the adoption, amendment, or repeal of regulations and for the meetings of public agencies.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

Relating to the notice requirements for the adoption, amendment, or repeal of regulations and for the meetings of public agencies.

* Section 1. AS 44.62.190(a) is amended to read:

(a) At least 30 days before the adoption, amendment, or repeal of a regulation, notice of the proposed action shall be

(1) published in the newspaper of general circulation, or trade or industry publication, that the state agency prescribes and in the Alaska Administrative Journal; publication in a newspaper or trade or industry publication may be supplemented by broadcasting the notice or an abbreviated form of the notice by television or radio;

(2) mailed to every person who has filed a request for notice of proposed action with the state agency;

(3) if the agency is within a department, mailed or delivered to the commissioner of the department;

(4) when appropriate in the judgment of the agency,

(A) mailed to a person or group of persons whom the agency believes is interested in the proposed action, and

(B) published in the additional form and manner the state agency prescribes;

(5) furnished the Department of Law together with a copy of the proposed regulation, amendment, or order of repeal for the department's use in preparing the opinion required after adoption and before

2 (6) furnished to all incumbent State of Alaska legislators
3 and the Legislative Affairs Agency;

4 (7) furnished to the standing committee of each house of
5 the legislature having legislative jurisdiction over the subject

7 State Legislature, together with a copy of the proposed regulation,
8 amendment, or order of repeal for the committee's use in conducting
9 the review authorized by AS 24.05.182;

12 * Sec. 2. AS 44.62.310(e) is amended to read:

13 (e) Reasonable public notice shall be given for all meetings
14 required to be open under this section. The notice must include the
15 date, time, and place of the meeting, and if the meeting is by tele-
16 conference the location of any teleconferencing facilities that will
17 be used. Except for the publication required by AS 44.62.175(a) in
18 the Alaska Administrative Journal, the notice may be given by using
19 print media supplemented by broadcast media.
