AN ACT

Authorizing the combining of a sales and use tax proposition with incorporation of a borough; and providing for an effective date.

\* Section 1. AS 29.45 is amended by adding a new section to article 4 to read:

Sec. 29.45.680. COMBINING SALES AND USE TAX WITH INCORPORATION OF A BOROUGH. A petition for incorporation of a borough may request that a sales and use tax proposition be placed on the same ballot. The petition must state the proposed tax rate. The petition may request that incorporation be dependent on the passage of the tax proposition; if so, the incorporation proposition fails if the tax proposition fails.

\* Sec. 2. Section 1 of this Act is retroactive to January 1, 1987.

\* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
