AN ACT

Amending the definition of "peace officer" in the Alaska Statutes to include village public safety officers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

AN ACT

Amending the definition of "peace officer" in the Alaska Statutes to include village public safety officers.

* Section 1. AS 01.10.060(7) is amended to read:

(7) "peace officer" means

(A) an [ANY] officer of the state troopers;

(B) a member [, MEMBERS] of the police force of a municipality;

(C) a village public safety officer;

(D) a [ANY INCORPORATED CITY OR BOROUGH,] United States marshal or deputy marshal; [MARSHALS AND THEIR DEPUTIES,]
and

(E) an officer [OTHER OFFICERS] whose duty it is to enforce and preserve the public peace;
